Details of minimum eligibility and other information Minimum qualification for direct requirement to the post of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor will be as laid down by UGC, New Delhi vide UGC Regulations 2018 on minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities and colleges vide notification No. 271 New Delhi, Wednesday July 18/ASHADHA 27, 1940 and as adopted by the University, from time to time.

Professor: Pay Scale (Pay Matrix level 14 as per VII CPC) Eligibility (A or B):

#### A.

- 1) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.
- ii) A minimum of ten years teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D Degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she

## Associate Professor: Pay Scale (Pay Matrix level 13 A as per VII CPC)

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines
- ii) A Master's Degree with atleast 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/Industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of Seventy Five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.

#### Assistant Professor: Pay Scale (Pay Matrix level 10 as per VII CPC) A.

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET
