The Research Score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer reviewed or UGC listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list)

- i) Paper in referred journals without Impact factor 05 points
- ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1-10 points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2-15 points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5-20 points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 25 points
- vi) Paper with impact factor >10-30 points
  - (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author
  - (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.
  - (c) Joint projects: Principal Investigator and Co-Investigator would get 50% each.

#### Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor
- Supervisor and co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each
- For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b) Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper Presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
